

St Thomas' Acceptable Use Policy – Remote Home Learning

This agreement will help to keep you and your teachers safe in the event of remote home learning. If we do have to work from home, we expect everyone to maintain the high standards of behaviour we set as a school.

I agree that...

- I will find a suitable learning environment to work in. I will need a table and chair within an enclosed space which is public but quiet, like a dining room. I agree not to work in my bedroom as this is my own private space.
- There will be an adult in the room whilst I am having my lesson. Even if I don't need their help, they will be there to make sure I am safe online.
- I will make sure that I am wearing appropriate clothing for my lesson, for example not my pyjamas. Anyone else who might be seen on my camera will also need to make sure they are dressed appropriately.
- I will ensure I still SLANT during remote learning, as I would in class. I agree not to be distracted by things like eating, playing with my pet, reading books etc.
- I will stick to deadlines, making sure I am on time for my lessons and that my Seesaw work is submitted for the time my teacher has asked for it and is of my best ability.
- During a lesson, I will keep my microphone on mute unless I am told otherwise by the teacher. I will not chat to others during the lesson or use the chat function unless we have been asked to do so by the teacher appropriately.
- I will use my real name for my lesson so that my teacher knows who I am. I will not add emojis or symbols to my screen-name.
- I will not take photographs, screenshots or record during the lesson. Filming or photographing others without their permission could get me in a lot of trouble.
