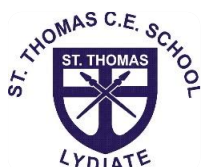

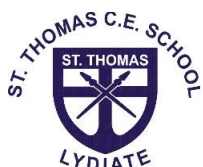

	Our first priority at St Thomas is for our pupils to feel happy and safe. We have well established routines for supporting pupils who need it: we offer lunchtime drop in sessions with our counsellor, Mrs Watkinson; we have worry monsters around school which every child can access and every class has a morning check in opportunity.

All staff are vigilant to noticing signs of bullying and we have effective systems in place to monitor behaviour and take action if necessary. Our safeguarding curriculum offers plenty of opportunities from EYFS to Y6 for children learn about what bullying looks like and what to do if they are concerned about bullying.

	Our pupils achieve very well at St Thomas. As you can see from our 2021 - 2022 results, children's attainment and progress is well above the national average. In fact, our data is amongst the highest within the local area and multi academy trust.
