Housekeeping

There are a few important housekeeping notes to share with you, so thank you for bearing with us.

Spare Clothes: Please ensure your child has a set of clearly labelled spare clothes in school. This should include socks, underwear, and an additional pair of bottoms (trousers/leggings or a skirt/dress). Labelling all items helps us to return belongings to the right children quickly.

Further to this, please ensure all jumpers/cardigans and both shoes are clearly labelled when sending your child into school.

Wellies and Wet Suits: As we head into the autumn and winter months, please send in a pair of clearly labelled wellies and a waterproof suit for your child as soon as possible. We love to play outside in all weathers and with the right clothing it's always great fun!

Tapestry: We hope you have all received your Tapestry account activation links and have enjoyed looking through this week's observations. If you haven't yet received your link, please let us know and we'll be happy to help.

Book Bag Reminder: Book bags only need to come into school on Fridays, ready for a new reading book. This helps to reduce the number of belongings children need to organise at the start and end of each day, making things simpler for them.

WhatsApp Group: A class WhatsApp group has been set up by parents. We know how valuable this can be for arranging playdates, helping the children's social interactions and keeping up to date with reminders. If you would like to be added to the group, please let me know and I can pass your mobile number on to the group admin.

Snack and Lunch Payment: Hopefully you have all been able to sign up to our payment system. We ask for a one-off snack payment of £50 for the year, which is now available to pay through the app. We kindly ask that this is paid as soon as possible.
